Services Provided:

- **GIS Applications Development Support**

GDM created FACTOVIEW, an ArcView cartographic utility to automate and streamline the production of urban area and state transportation maps. DOT staff previously took hours of staff time responding to map requests for briefing trips taken by Transportation Secretary Ron Slater and other high-ranking officials.

- **Internet Map Server Database and GIS Clearinghouse for Transportation**

GDM is developing a BTS GIS Clearinghouse to facilitate internet, map-based search and retrieval of transportation data layers as part of the Federal Geographic Data Committee (FGDC) Clearinghouse.

- **Cartographic and Graphic Support for Maps and Reports**

GDM is providing quality maps, analytic products, and graphics for the high-profile DOT Reports. GDM also developed an enhanced version of the 20- by 32-inch National Transportation Facilities Poster that incorporates shaded relief imagery.

- **GIS Database and Analytical Support**
