- **Environmental Health Risks:** *GDM has implemented a county-wide GIS aimed at identifying the location of on-site sewage disposal systems and their proximity to wetlands, creeks, 100-year flood plans and other areas associated with risk to surface water resources. The project provided agency staff with the tools and information to prioritize inspection and permitting resources.*
- **Support for Wetland Protection and Restoration:** *Setting regional priorities for wetland protection helps target limited resources. GDM integrates existing wetland delineations together with satellite imagery and other data using the latest concepts and models.*



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
